Prayer #34:

Focus Point: So much has been written about love, all different kinds of love. As the gospel writer John tells us, all love comes from God and leads to God. The sacrificing love of a parent, the understanding love of a friend, the passionate love of newlyweds and the serene love of a mature couple are all some of God's beautiful creations! God created the unconditional and forgiving love of our Savior, Jesus Christ, and created in Him a human heart. Jesus loved His fellow humans through this tender and compassionate heart, and asked us to "Love one another as I have loved you." Those that follow this commandment benefit greatly, for as they express their love for others, they gain the love of God, and feel His presence within their own hearts.
