



## 1st Reading for The Feast of the Assumption of Mary, the Mother of God

### The Book of Revelation Chapter 12-13 The Image of the Woman Clothed with the Sun

In the first reading for the feast of the Assumption, we are presented with an image of a “woman clothed with the sun,” standing on the moon, and 12 stars around her. This image is presented in the Book of Revelation by John of Patmos.

It was a familiar image to the many people of the Roman Empire, especially in Greece and Asia minor (present day Turkey) and Rome. It reminded them of the myth of the birth of the god Apollo, from his mother Leto, and Python, the dragon who was sent to destroy them both.

Apollo became associated with Helios, the Greek sun god. He drove a four-horse chariot across the sky each day. The chariot contained the sun. Apollo was sometimes referred to as Apollo Helios. The sun god was also depicted as driving a chariot in Roman culture, and identified with the Roman solar divinity.

Several of the emperors claimed descent from the god Apollo, beginning with Augustus, in 36 B.C., when the Republic of Rome was formed. Like the god, the emperors’ images on coins (coins were a major form of propaganda) showed beams of sunlight radiating from the emperor’s heads. The mother *was interpreted* to the goddess Roma. Rome and its emperors took credit for establishing peace and destroying the chaos monster, the Dragon of the Book of Revelation <sup>(1)</sup>.

For Christians, it would have resonated with the birth of Jesus. Mary was the woman who brought forth the Messiah. The dragon represented Satan. The 12 stars were the 12 Apostles. Satan tried to destroy Jesus at his birth, through his agent, Herod the Great of Judea. Remember how he sent soldiers to kill the Holy Innocents in Bethlehem; the Holy family was spared by the flight to Egypt.

The 12 stars of the image represent the 12 Apostles, reminiscent of the 12 tribes of Israel. Michael, the archangel, has been and is, the guardian Angel defender of Israel.

## A SPIRITUAL SUPPLEMENT?

### *A reflection for August 11, The Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

Balance of Nature, Super Beets, Field of Greens, and Prevagen are heavily advertised supplements. We are told that these products, and others like them, can better our physical well-being, sharpen our memory, increase our energy, enhance our immune system, etc. Take the right pill and you are on your way to better health.

There is always a danger that we can see the Eucharist as simply a type of "spiritual supplement" that nourishes our soul and improves our spiritual well-being. Sunday Mass is simply the ritual that allows us to come forward and receive this aid to our spiritual life. Just as the Jewish people were given manna to nourish them on their way to the Promised Land, we may think of the Eucharist as the "manna" that we are given to strengthen us for our journey through life.

However, the Eucharist is not something that we are given to fortify our souls, rather the Eucharist is someone. The Eucharist is our personal encounter with the Risen Lord who is truly present—body, blood, soul and divinity—in the consecrated bread and wine that we are privileged to receive. As Jesus tells us in Sunday's Gospel (John 6:41-51), "I am the living bread that comes down from heaven....the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

When we receive Communion, we encounter the same Risen Lord who appeared to his startled disciples that first Easter, who broke bread with the two disciples on the road to Emmaus, who showed Thomas his wounded hands and side, who prepared breakfast for his disciples at the Sea of Galilee, and who commissioned his followers to go and make disciples of all nations.

As we receive Holy Communion, the Risen Lord stands before us and says, "Take and eat this is my body, take and drink this is my blood." As we do, we become a "holy communion with him."

We know what makes the greatest improvement in our everyday lives is not the supplements we take, but rather the people who generously give us their love, tenderness, and compassion. The same is true in our spiritual lives. When we receive the Eucharist, the Lord does not give us something to take, he gives us Himself!
