Our Lady's Little Known Sacramental for Healing and Conversion

Miraculous Healings and Conversions are attached to this Sacramental dedicated to Our Lady of the Immaculate Heart.

Have you ever heard of the Green Scapular of the Immaculate Heart?

Many miraculous healings and conversions are attached to this sacramental dedicated to Our Lady's Immaculate Heart.

Our Lady gave us the Green Scapular to St. Justine Bisqueyburu of the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul. After several visions, Our Lady presented the Green Scapular on September 8, 1940. Our Lady appeared with her heart engulfed in flames in one hand and the scapular in the other. The scapular consisted of green cloth attached to a green cord.

One side of the scapular displayed her apparition. The other side depicted a heart set ablaze and pierced with a sword, "with rays more brilliant than the sun and clearer than crystal." Inscribed in an oval around Our Lady's heart were these words: **"Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us now and at the hour of our death."**

At the time of the apparition, Sr. Justine heard interiorly that the scapular "should be shared with the world as an instrument in the conversion of souls." **Pope Pius IX approved this sacramental in 1863 and again in 1870.** He said, "Write to these good Sisters that I authorize them to make and distribute it."

A priest should bless the scapular and the devotee should wear it, saying the inscribed prayer regularly and with confidence. To help another person obtain grace, the devotee may secretly place the scapular in a home, for example, and pray the inscribed prayer for the individual.

Testimony by Robert A. Macdonald, C. Ss. R.: This is my only way of trying to spread a true and tender love of Her Immaculate Heart and of paying my debt to Her. Some years ago, before penicillin was in use, I was lying in a hospital very ill with pneumonia. I began to hemorrhage and the doctors decided to operate as a last resource. Then a little nun came into my room, "Father, Have you great faith in the Mother of God, especially in Her Immaculate Heart? If so, you can be cured." "How sister?"

She answered "Through the Green Scapular." "What is that?"

She replied "Four years ago, I was operated on for cancer. I was so filled with it, that they just closed me up and sent me away to die. Then I prayed to Our Lady of the Green Scapular, grew tired of waiting to die and came back to work." "I am cured, do you want me to give you a Scapular?" "Please, Sister."

With that she put one over my head. A feeling of tremendous confidence poured into me and the bleeding stopped. Two days later, in the X-ray room, they asked me when the bleeding had ceased. When I replied that it was a couple of days, they expressed great surprise."

You have a wound that is six months healed and there is no other mark."

Today even the scars are gone. No wonder I speak of an unpayable debt to Her Immaculate Heart. Since then I have done everything possible to foster this devotion. To my great joy and amazement, those to whom I have spoken of the Green Scapular have become more zealous than I. Never have I seen the equal of the faith and confidence of these new apostles of Mary."

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us now and the hour of our death!

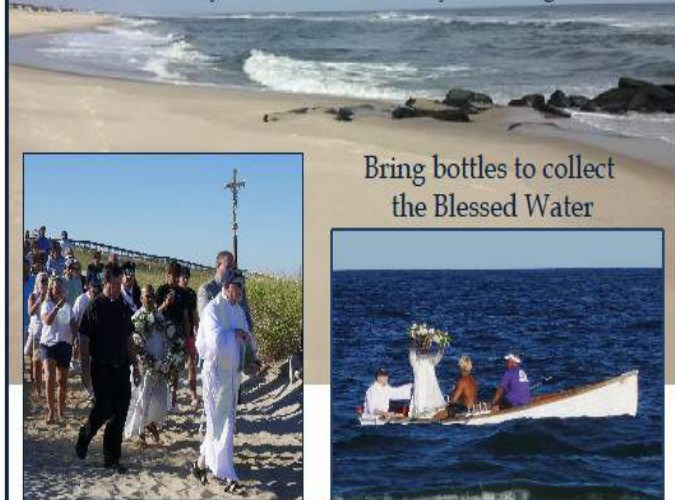

Margaret and her husband were sent a sonogram picture of their granddaughter and told to pray for her. The doctors found a tumor on her kidney and were concerned about operating on her in utero or waiting until she was born. They ultimately decided to wait until she was born. Concerned for their granddaughter they decided to go to one of our healing masses for a miracle.

In 2022, when it was their turn to approach Fr. Pio Mandato at our Healing Mass, they showed him their phone with the picture of the sonogram and begged for a cure. Fr. Pio gently put the relic of St. Padre Pio's glove over the phone and prayed in silence. He then said to them, I am praying don't worry. She will be fine. Padre Pio will hold her in the palm of his hand.

Four months later baby Alessandra was born. The doctors ran multiple tests to prepare for surgery to remove the growth and it was not there. It vanished! They received a miracle!!!! Anointing of the Sick - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

Receiving Communion:

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest. Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and homebound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

Sponsorship Certificates - Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained. ****Children of parishioners over 21 years of age should register independently.****

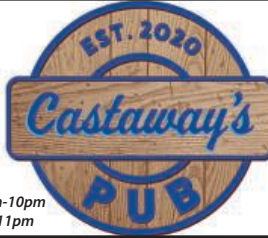
