Charitable Giving and Tax Planning Information

Dear Parishioners:

At the end of 2019 lawmakers made a number of changes via The Secure Act which effects the distribution of IRA monies. One very notable change is to the “stretch IRA Rules” which require a non-spouse beneficiary to withdraw their entire IRA inheritance within 10-years instead of being able to hold and/or pass on wealth to multi-generations. This might cause some beneficiaries to incur very large tax burdens as they withdraw Inherited IRA monies, which is Taxable Income. I would like to take this time for a reminder that you can contribute directly from your IRA to our parish (or any other charity) and because those charitable donations are tax-free withdrawals (but still qualify as Required Minimum Distributions) it can be beneficial to your personal taxes. Below is information from our investment firm:

Do you want to benefit one or more charities during your lifetime and are age 70½ or older? If so, you can transfer up to \$100,000 of IRA withdrawals each year directly to a qualified charity without recognizing these withdrawals as income. This type of IRA withdrawal is known as a “Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)” and it will count toward satisfying the required minimum distribution (RMD) you must take from your traditional IRA(s) each year after reaching age 72.

Several of your fellow parishioners have already taken advantage of this idea, contributing directly from their IRA to our parish (some do it in lieu of their weekly donations). If you would like more information about how to do this or how we can split your donation between our parish and our other charities (Special Collections, our various building projects, Holiday & Holy Day Collections, Flowers, the Annual Catholic Appeal, or toward your pledge to Faith to Move Mountains) please give me a call.

I also have information on charitable stock transfers or remembering your parish in your will or trust. Thank you for your continued support of our parish.

Receiving Communion:

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. To receive on the tongue please wait until all have received, go to the end of the line of the priest distributing Communion.
- Anyone needing a **low gluten host**, please get in the communion line in the front, on the pulpit side. Ask the minister for a low gluten Host.
- To take Communion from Mass to **homebound family members**, go to the sacristy after Mass with your pyx. Ask the priest/minister to get you a host from the tabernacle. Hosts for others will not be distributed during Mass.

Collection Baskets are at the main doors of the Church or give your envelope to an usher as you exit. There is a secure drop box in the foyer of the parish office for contributions and correspondence. We recommend Online Giving, visit our website for easy signup information.

Dress Code: The summer months may be very hot and uncomfortable, but please remember to always dress modestly for Mass. Thank you.

Sponsorship Certificate/ Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

****Children of parishioners over 21 years of age should register independently.****
