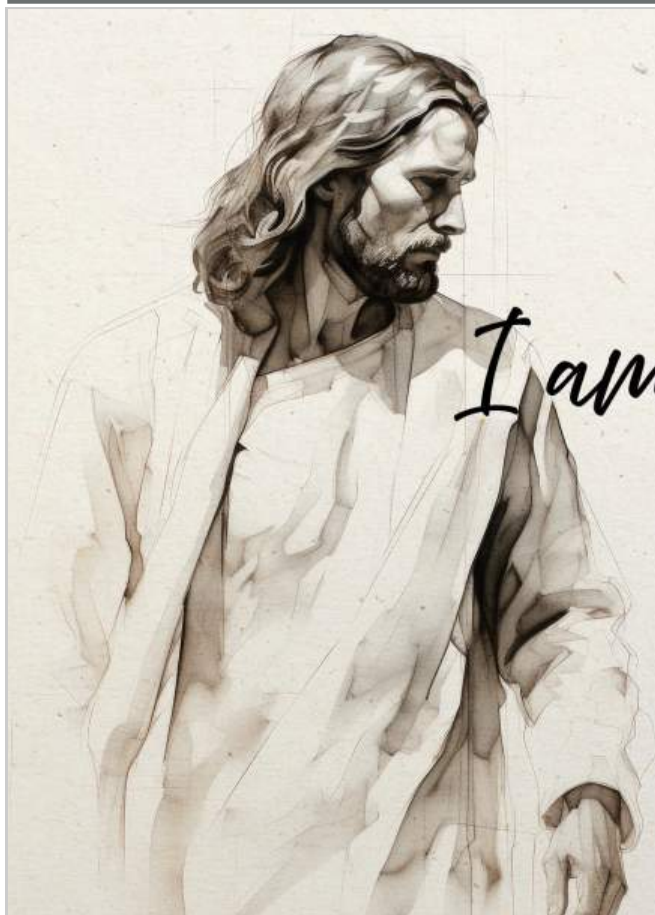

## A "MASS" GATHERING- A reflection for August 4

Recently there have been "mass baptisms" in various parts of the country. It was reported that this past May, some 6,000 people were baptized over two days at Huntington State Beach in California. During such baptisms, powerful messages are preached by Christian evangelists, people join in emotional worship, dynamic testimonies of faith are delivered, and a strong sense of community is created. Those in the audience are then invited to publicly acknowledge Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Those who do so are immediately baptized. Such baptisms take place on ocean beaches, in lakes and rivers, and other places prepared for the occasion. Such events are no doubt moments of conversion and revival. But putting one's faith in Christ requires more than simply acknowledging the Lordship of Jesus and being baptized. In Sunday's Gospel when the crowd asks Jesus what work they must do to gain eternal life, he responds, "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent." Believing in Jesus requires living like him. It means letting the will of God guide our decisions and actions as Jesus did.

In our Second Reading, Saint Paul stresses that believing in Jesus means acting according to the truth revealed in him. It means putting aside "the old self of your former way of life" and putting on "the new self, created in God's way in righteousness and holiness of truth." Baptism is a joyful moment during which the presence of God is particularly powerful. But that moment must be followed by a lifetime of moments during which we work to truly live out our belief in the Lord Jesus.

As Catholics we are strengthened to do that at every Sunday Mass. At that weekly "mass" gathering, we are fed with the Eucharist, "the true bread from heaven" that empowers us to continue our journey of faith begun in baptism. The baptism of a mass of people, like any baptism, is only the start of something. We might say that a person's baptism is just the first day of work.

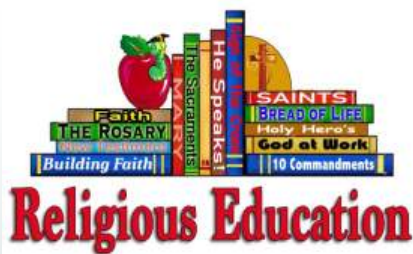
