

### **Padre Pio Prayer Anthology Prayer #38:**

**Focus Point:** There is an old Catholic tradition dating back to the 15th century that on August 15th, the Feast of the Assumption, there is a healing power in the waters of the sea placed there by the Blessed Mother. Some coastal parishes process to the ocean, carry a statue of Mary, toss flowers into the water, pray the Magnificat and sprinkle Holy Water into the ocean. Many believe that healing can occur by wading in the water. Some bring the ocean water home in bottles. Regardless of the details of what people believe, this tradition is a testament to the strength of our Catholic belief in the power of the Blessed Virgin Mary to intercede with her beloved son, Jesus, on our behalf! It is a testament to the power of prayer in our lives! It is a testament to the love of our mother, Mary, for all of us who ask sincerely and humbly for her help with our difficulties, and for her guidance in our lives!

**Prayer for Strengthening our Belief in the Power of Mary:** Dear Lord, open my eyes to the power of Your Mother's love for me. Help me to turn to her in time of need. Encourage me to pray to her openly and honestly. Dear Mary, hold me in your loving arms and bring me the comfort of your love and your tender care. Teach me to accept the will of your Son, and to turn to you as an example of patience and holiness. Treat me as a child who does not know where to turn. Look at me with your eyes filled with love and compassion, and listen to my heartfelt petitions. Please pray with me and keep me on the powerful path of prayer to you. May my trust in you bring me into a closer relationship with Jesus! Amen.

**Closing thoughts:** Tell Jesus what is in your heart. Thank Him for your gifts and most of all, thank Him for loving you with His Most Sacred Heart!

## NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### Practices & Promises of the Flame of Love of the Immaculate Heart of Mary By Christine Watkins-Part 1



In the troubling times in which we live, Jesus and His Mother, through recent movement in the heavens and in the Church, are laying extraordinary graces in our laps for our disposal. One such movement is “The Flame of Love of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,” a new name given to that immense and eternal love that Mary has for all her children. The movement’s foundation is The Spiritual Diary of Hungarian mystic Elizabeth Kindelmann, in which Jesus and Mary teach Elizabeth and the faithful the divine art of suffering for the salvation of souls.



Tasks are assigned for each day of the week, involving prayer, fasting, and night vigils, with beautiful promises attached to them, laced with special graces for priests and the souls in purgatory. In their messages to Elizabeth, Jesus and Mary say that “The Flame of Love of the Immaculate Heart of Mary” is :the greatest grace given to mankind since the Incarnation.” And in the not-so-distant future, her flame will engulf the entire world.

Cardinal and Archbishop Peter Erdő of Esztergom-Budapest, Primate of Hungary, established a commission to study The Spiritual Diary and the various recognitions that local bishops around the world had given to The Flame of Love movement, as a private association of the faithful.

In 2009, the cardinal not only gave the imprimatur to The Spiritual Diary, but recognized Elizabeth’s mystical locutions and writings as authentic, a “gift to the Church.”

In addition, he gave his episcopal approval of the Flame of Love movement, which has formally operated within the Church for over twenty years.

Currently, the movement is seeking further approbation as a Public Association of the Faithful. On June 19, 2013, Pope Francis gave to it his Apostolic Blessing.

Elizabeth Szántó was born in Budapest. She was the thirteenth child (preceded by six pairs of twins). She, alone, survived into adulthood. Elizabeth was orphaned at a young age. Her father died when she was about five. Because of her poor health, she lived for a time with her grandparents in the countryside. From ages 6 to 10, she attended elementary school. Then, she went to Switzerland, returned to Budapest, and later was supposed to be adopted by a Swiss family. However, she was late for the train and a young couple took her back to Budapest. In Budapest began the struggle of a 13-year-old orphan who needed to find work so she did not starve. As a lonely orphan who was often taken advantage of, she had many different jobs. Twice she tried to enter religious congregations, but was rejected. Fortunately, she discovered a Father Motray who became her confessor for many years.

The turning point came in August 1929 when she was accepted for the parish choir. There she met Karoly Kindlemann, a chimneysweeper instructor (a good paying position). She was married at 16 (May 25, 1930). They had six children (1931 – 1942). In 1946, her husband died.

In 1948, the Communist Nationalization of Hungary was harsh. She was fired for political reasons (having a statue of the Blessed Mother in her home). By May 1951, she was in a humanly hopeless situation. Fortunately, she became a technical supervisor at a foundry. This saved her family from starvation. She worked at a number of factories. Her children married and, with their grandchildren, moved back in with Elizabeth. Her diary begins on July 13, 1960, when she wrote about the beginning religious experience that introduced her to God’s presence. It speaks of three years of spiritual darkness (1958 – 1961) that prepared her for the locutions. The decisive moment came on July 16, 1961, the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel (Elizabeth was a lay Carmelite). This leads us into her diary, where she herself tells the story.

**Anointing of the Sick** - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

#### **Receiving Communion:**

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and home-bound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

### PROMISE TO PROTECT- PLEDGE TO HEAL

The Diocese of Trenton is committed to the initiatives outlined in the U.S. Bishops' Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People and to its own policies and guidelines in regard to the reporting and investigation of sexual abuse allegations involving minors. ### Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

*Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).*

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.
