

## Padre Pio Prayer Anthology

**Prayer #30** Focus idea: December is a busy and demanding month! We feel the pressure of “getting ready” for Christmas! We want so badly to show our love to those we care about, by giving the perfect gift, or preparing the perfect meal! Can we possibly find the time and the motivation to share what we have with those that we don’t even know? Jesus asks us to give up what we have and follow Him! In today’s world, we probably couldn’t give up everything that we have, but maybe we could “take on” the needs of others who are struggling. Start small - challenge yourself to give up just one thing that you enjoy doing this holiday season. Devote that time to pray for the needs of others or even better yet, volunteer that time to be helpful to others. Fr. Joy suggests that we allow Jesus to search our hearts, and “let His light reveal the mercy, goodness, and generosity that is already there”. Now we just need the will to act upon our own goodness. Rest assured that God will then be blessing you with His priceless gifts of love, pride and appreciation!

## **Oplatki Wafers Available**

The family-centered tradition of sharing Oplatki before the Christmas Eve meal is a wonderful celebration of love and forgiveness that has its origins in Poland. Family members and guests each break a piece of the wafer and share it with the next person at the table along with an expression of love, blessing and, sometimes, forgiveness. In America, it is often referred to as "Christmas Wafers." Each package includes 3 white wafers, 1 pink wafer and pamphlet with prayers and an explanation of this Christmas tradition. ### St. Bonaventure Church Building Roof Replacement Project

The slate roof on our church was 56 years old and needed to be replaced. The Southern Sloped roof was definitely in worse shape than the Northern side. While a replacement roof with real slate was considered, it was very cost prohibitive (over \$500,000). Instead, we chose to replace the roof with “high-end premium shingles” with a 40-year warranty. Also, new flashing was installed and new gutters and leaders. This part of the project is complete.

Additionally, our Flat roof is 18 years old; it has many areas of standing water from the bad slope and many holes from piercings from falling slate over the years. It needs to be re-sloped, have drains added and a new membrane installed. We are awaiting material delivery to complete this part of the project and hopefully will be able to do so in the Spring.

The total cost for the project is \$350,000. St. Pio Parish is fortunate to have reserves on hand to fund Building Preservation projects such as this. However, it is also necessary to replenish these funds. This weekend we will have a Second Collection to help replenish the funds for the Roof Project. We thank you for your generosity.

## Second Sunday of Advent

**FROM FR. JOE:**

### **How to Go to confession**

#### **1. Examination of Conscience**

**Before you go to confession** make sure you take some time to prepare at home or when you arrive at Church. This means making a thorough Examination of Conscience. If it helps you to remember, don't hesitate to write down your sins. You should probably do this at home before you go to the church, and destroy the list afterwards.

#### **Pray a Prayer Before Going to Confession.**

Come Holy Spirit into my soul. Enlighten my mind that I may know the sins I ought to confess, and grant me Your grace to confess them fully, humbly and with contrite heart. Help me to firmly resolve not to commit them again. O Blessed Virgin, Mother of my Redeemer, intercede for me through the Passion of Your Son, that I may obtain the grace to make a good confession.

Amen.

#### **2. Beginning** when you enter the Confessional.

Usually the priest will begin by saying:

**In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.**

While he is saying this, make the sign of the cross and respond:

**Amen.**

Then you say:

**Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been (how long) since my last confession, and these are my sins.**

#### **3. Confession of Sins**

Now, list the sins you have committed since your last confession that came to mind when doing your examination of conscience.

**Tips:** Be brief, concise, and frank about your sins. Don't "beat around the bush."

Just confess your sins. Just tell the priest what you have done, don't try to justify it.

Don't be too general (e.g., "I haven't been a good person"), but a lot of detail is not necessary either (you don't need to tell the whole story of how a sin came about).

If you're not sure if something is a sin, just ask the priest.


#### **5. Recite the Act of Contrition**

After you have received your penance, you need to express contrition (sorrow) for your sins. You can either do this from the heart, or you can use one of the traditional formulas for your act of contrition. This prayer is prayed out loud.

#### **6. Receive Absolution**

The priest will then recite God's absolution from your sins. As the priest is finishing the absolution, and makes the Sign of the Cross over you, you should make the Sign of the Cross yourself. When he is finishing the Absolution, you respond:

**Amen.**



As sinners we are not “pure and blameless” but we can become pure and blameless through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

During Advent **GO TO CONFSSION** to prepare for the birth of our Lord and for the good of our own eternal life. Be and act pro-life.

Dear Parishioners:

As we approach the end of 2021 you might be planning your end of year finances/taxes and charitable giving. I would like to take this time for a reminder that you can contribute directly from your IRA to our parish (or any other charity) and it can be beneficial to your personal taxes. Below is information from our investment firm:

*Do you want to benefit one or more charities during your lifetime and are age 70½ or older? If so, you can transfer up to \$100,000 of IRA withdrawals each year directly to a qualified charity without recognizing these withdrawals as income. This type of IRA withdrawal is known as a “Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)” and it will count toward satisfying the required minimum distribution (RMD) you must take from your traditional IRA(s) each year after reaching age 70½.*

Several of your fellow parishioners have already taken advantage of this idea, contributing directly from their IRA to our parish (some do it in lieu of their weekly donations). If you would like more information about how to do this or how we can split your donation between our parish and our other charities (Special Collections, Holiday & Holy Day Collections, Flowers, the Annual Catholic Appeal, or finishing your pledge to Faith to Move Mountains) please give me a call.

I also have information on charitable stock transfers or remembering your parish in your will or trust. Thank you for your continued support of our parish.

### Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

*Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).*

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.
