

### Padre Pio Prayer Anthology

Our first parish prayer anthology will include many types of prayers. We will begin our collection with prayers that you can use to develop a relationship with God that is more personal and intimate.

### Prayer #32

We clearly live in a world that is multi-cultural and multi-problematic. In all corners of the world, personal crises invade all cultures and classes. Where do we turn when life's many problems hit home? We are all united as children of God and all dependent on Him for strength, peace and hope. God is the only constant in our lives - always there to inspire us and bless us with His grace and love. How is it that some people become despondent, and others calmly formulate a plan of action? The answer lies in prayer. Prayer opens a dialogue with God. Prayer allows us to form a meaningful relationship with God. And prayer helps us to form a partnership with God, bringing us the comfort that we all constantly seek! Fr. Joy reminds us that, "God never tests us beyond what we can endure. The effect of our trust in God is that we will rise above our difficulties with strength and confidence!"

### **Prayer for True Belief in the Power and Peace of Prayer:**

Dear Jesus, please help me to truly trust in the power of Your love to bring me peace and comfort in the difficult moments of my life. Help me to turn to You through sincere prayer. Help me to seek an honest, genuine and constant relationship with You in times of sorrow AND in times of joy! Please continue to fill the emptiness inside of me when I am scared, or afraid of what lies ahead. Help me to explore new ways to pray and to recognize that praying the rosary or a novena shows my steadfast belief and my dedication to You. Help me to expand the number of people that I pray for, and help them to learn to find Your comfort through their own prayers. Remind me to enjoy the feeling of Your love inside my heart, and to show my appreciation by the way that I live my life. Let me live in Your love all the days of my life as I try to live my life in Your image and likeness. Amen.

### **Closing thoughts:**

Tell Jesus what is in your heart. Thank Him for your gifts and most of all, thank Him for loving you with His most Sacred Heart!

If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

### **Receiving Communion:**

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. To receive on the tongue please wait until all have received, go to the end of the line of the priest distributing Communion.
- Anyone needing a <u>low gluten host</u>, please get in the communion line in the front, on the pulpit side. Ask the minister for a low gluten Host.
- To take Communion from Mass to <u>homebound family</u> <u>members</u>, go to the sacristy <u>after Mass</u> with your pyx. Ask the priest/minister to get you a host from the tabernacle. Hosts for others will not be distributed during Mass.

### Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

\*\*Children of parishioners over 21 years of age should register independently.\*\*
