From Fr. Joe, Part II

Keep Away from Occult Practices! They are a serious danger!

Some psychics and mediums know that the power operating through them is coming from an evil spirit. Others have been duped by evil spirits into believing the power is coming directly from them. The devil knows what he is plotting against someone and will use psychics and mediums in order to manipulate people for his own purposes. We need to be wary of them since they may use Christian symbols, such as a crucifix or an image of the Blessed Mother, in order to lure people in by giving them a false sense of security that there is nothing wrong with what they are doing. The First Letter of John makes it very clear that “many false prophets have gone out into the world” (4:1), and “every spirit which does not confess Jesus is not of God” (4:3). The devil has every motivation to get us to engage in practices that break the First Commandment.

When people allow themselves to be duped by psychics and mediums, the result is the establishment of a relationship between the person and the forces of evil. At first there are thrills and fascinations with what the person is hearing through the psychic or medium, but eventually the demonic presence will reveal itself and the person’s life will begin to unravel. When the devil gives something, he will expect something in return. When power is gained, and special favors granted through the assistance of the devil and his angels, they will expect to be paid in full. The price demanded is our destruction through the loss of our soul. Magic is an effective destructive weapon of the devil due to weak religious convictions. St. John Paul II has said, “The weakening of faith leads to a degeneration into magical practices.”

My best advice is to forget about magic and the world of the occult and always turn to God through prayer for the answers we are seeking. The Book of Joshua says it best, “but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord” (24:15).

Other good Catholic books on Exorcism and the Occult which I have read are:

Demonic Foes: My 25 years as a psychiatrist Investigating Possessions, Diabolic attacks, and the Paranormal. By Dr. Richard Gallagher M.D., a practicing psychiatrist. He is a professor of Psychiatry on the faculty of Columbia University. He is the world’s foremost scientific expert on diabolic attacks, and an active member of the International Association of Exorcists.

And

Diary of an American Exorcist: Demons, Possession, and the Modern-Day Battle Against Ancient Evil. By Msgr. Steven Rossetti (Sophia Press). He has been a practicing Exorcist and is also the president and founder of the St. Michael Center for Spiritual Renewal, a nonprofit Catholic organization that oversees the exorcism sessions around the DC area. He is a licensed psychologist and research associate professor at the Catholic University of America.

Battling demonic forces is regular duty for Msgr. Rossetti, a Catholic priest who worked in two parishes in the Diocese of Syracuse for five years. Now based in the Washington, DC, diocese. He and his team perform up to 20 exorcisms each week, liberating people — and homes — from what he calls “demons and satanic evil.”

Receiving Communion:

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and home-bound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

GOD OF LOVE AND LIFE: FATHER, SON and HOLY SPIRIT

"You were buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead." Colossians 2:12

As followers of Jesus, having been raised with him from the dead, we cannot think and act as the world thinks and acts. We have to listen to the word of God and do His will. We have to love Him above all else. This means if the whole world is acting against God's will - we cannot. If the whole world supports abortion - we cannot. As true believers we cannot support those who do or support evil.

Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.
