Do You Believe Jesus Is God?

The miraculous feeding of the multitude seems to many of us, to be too difficult to believe, especially feeding over 5,000 men, as well as women and children. Some have tried to explain it away, claiming it as a “parable,” by which they mean “not a genuine historical event,” or a “miraculous sharing,” in which people in the crowd actually had food themselves that was hidden, and are then inspired by Jesus’ preaching to share it. Even Pope Francis explained it that way last year. Some omit focusing on it and try only to compare it to the first reading about the miraculous feeding by Elisha, or the feeding by God of Manna when the Hebrew people were in the wilderness. Certainly, it was intended to show that Jesus, as God, could do such a marvel. I have come to believe that it was a genuine event in the life of Jesus. It is something that only God could do.

When we think about it by trying to explain it away as something other than the “miracle” that it is, we are admitting our lack of faith that Jesus is God. Whether it is the miracle of “Jesus walking on water,” or the wedding feast at Cana, or Jesus’ resurrection from the dead, or the Virgin birth, the Gospels challenge us to believe seemingly impossible things.

In 1917, there was a miracle of the “spinning sun” at Fatima, Portugal. Over 70,000 people witnessed it. It was an unbelievable event, yet it did happen, through God’s grace working through Mary.

We have just celebrated the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, and the focus was on the “real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.” This is an even greater miracle than the feeding of the multitude.

May God give us all the grace to believe and rejoice with joy, not skepticism, at His mighty deeds and the miracles of Jesus His Son.

Stained Glass Window Restoration Project at Sacred Heart Church

Some of our beautiful stained-glass windows at Sacred Heart Church are in serious need of repair. The steel frames are rusting, the ventilators inoperable, and in some places have become deformed causing the delicate stained glass to break. We have decided to repair the most critical windows this year and will attend to the rest of the windows in the future, perhaps a few each year.

On Monday, July 22nd, we will begin **Phase 1** of the project to repair and restore the stained-glass windows behind the Altar (both the large Nativity Window and the two side-lite windows) and the large window behind the choir loft. The windows will be removed and taken back to the studio to be cleaned and restored. The window openings will be boarded up until the repaired windows are finished. When reinstalled, the exterior wood frames will be repaired or replaced and new, properly ventilated outer protective coverings will be installed. The cost of this project is \$77,363.

We will all miss our beautiful windows while they are gone and look forward to their return in early September.
