Jesus Invites Us Into His Divine Healing Power!

An Evening of Mercy with **Fr. Pio Mandato**,
a spiritual son of St. Padre Pio

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened,
and I will give you rest.

Take my yoke upon you and learn from me,
for I am gentle and humble in heart,
and you will find rest for your souls.

Come and pray with us, and bring those you love who are in need of healing, and Fr. Mandato will lead us in prayer and bless us with a blood-stained glove of St. Pio's stigmatized hand, given to him by Padre Pio himself. If your loved ones are unable to come, you can be a proxy for them, by printing their name on a Holy Card. Holy Cards will be provided, but bring a pen. Everyone will also have an opportunity for a healing confession.

When: Wednesday, August 10, 2022, from 5:30 P.M. until 9:00 P.M.

Where: St. Pio's Parish Church, right off Route 35, 1100 Grand Central Ave, Lavallette, NJ

Schedule:

5:30 p.m. Confessions begin. There will be 7 priests available for confessions throughout the evening.

We will be praying the Holy Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet as we begin confessions

6:30 Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

6:45 Gospel Reading and Talk by Fr. Pio Mandato

8:10 Benediction

8:15 Healing Service of individuals who would like to be prayed with and blessed with St. Pio's Glove- after which you can leave. Please let all of those who are handicapped receive a blessing first, before everyone else. They are our privileged guests.

Around 8:45 there will be a closing prayer with all who are present

Fr. Pio Mandato was born in Italy. His parents came from Pietrelcina in Southern Italy, the same town as Saint Pio, the famous stigmatist priest whom they knew very well. Fr. Pio received his first holy communion from Saint Pio before coming to the USA. He grew up in New Jersey and entered the Capuchin Franciscans at the age of 17, where he received his Franciscan formation and later his priestly ordination in 1985.

In 1998 after being accepted into the Diocese of Scranton by Bishop Timlin D. D., he began living a life of solitude and prayer consisting of Adoring the Lord, Prayerful intercession for the Church in her needs, living a life of repentance and conversion and of joyful Thanksgiving in the Franciscan charism. He is also Chaplain to the Capuchin Sisters of Nazareth and at times goes forth to preach retreats.

Suggestions to Help You Make a Good, Healing, Confession

Try to be free of distractions when you are examining your conscience. Begin by praying to the Holy Spirit to help you bring your sins and failings to mind. Pray to your guardian angel and/or a special saint of yours, to help you stay focused, honest and humble. You might begin with a **copy of a good examination of conscience.** There are plenty of them published on the internet or in books. You might want to bring a copy of one with you, for when you are standing in line for confession.

I have found that it is best for me (Fr. Joe) to prepare for confession over a few days before I go, and write my sins down, and review and pray about the items mentioned during a few days of time. If this is a good idea for you, *Don't put your name on this paper* or share it. Treat it as a very confidential document. Use very short phrases, or one, or a few key words that will bring your sin to mind to you, without revealing your sin directly to anyone else. After confession, destroy the paper. Its' only purpose is to aid you in making a good confession.

Slow down, and take your time. to go through your sins, and don't forget to **mention the things you've not done**, like pray, for give, or to be merciful, etc.

Be specific, no need to give the priest all the details, or yours or other people's names. What caused you to sin? Is there a time of day [this sin] happens? Is this sin habitual or re-occurring? Is there a common thread to your giving-in to this temptation? Sometimes in a good confession, we uncover things about ourselves that are much deeper and uglier than what we think at first- glance, but do not be afraid. Pray for the grace of honesty, courage, to confess your sins. Don't dance around the issue when talking to the priest in confession. —confess what you did. Sin is a disease, and a disease cannot be removed or healed until it is properly identified.

Stay Humble, Honest and as Complete as you can be.

Whatever you do, remain humble, and *listen* to what the priest is telling you. Don't be defensive. You can ask questions about sins you are unsure of, or if you need clarification.

Absolution is complete and final. If you have properly prepared, you should have zero doubts about the finality of your absolution... After confession, don't be obsessive about forgetting something or wanting to go back.

As Jesus tells us in Divine Mercy:
"Trust in Me."

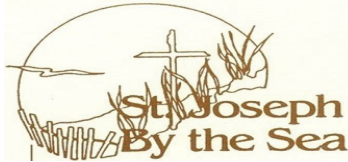
Anointing of the Sick - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

Receiving Communion:

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and homebound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

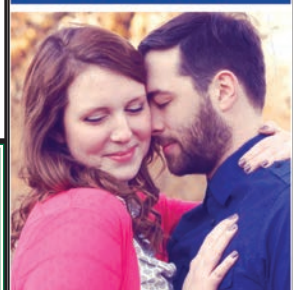
