## From the Desk of the Pastor:

### **The Cedars of Lebanon or the Mustard Seed Kingdom; which one do you choose?**

The first reading this Sunday reflects the attitudes and stances of the prophet Ezekiel versus the worldly powers of Empires. Ezekiel uses the symbol of the cedars of Lebanon and compares them to the Power of the Assyrian Empire. The cedars of Lebanon are a very ancient symbol of strength and power and wealth. The Lebanese still display it as a symbol of pride on their flag to this day.

If you remember, in the Bible, when King David had his palace built in Jerusalem, he used Cedars of Lebanon. His son Solomon used Cedars of Lebanon to build the first temple in Jerusalem.

Cedars of Lebanon were famous because they were mighty trees that even grew in the harsh cold weather 6,000 ft. above sea level in the mountains. They can grow up to 150' high. There are a few estimated to be over 3,000 years old. The timber was prized because it is extremely strong and lasts many hundreds of years, used over and over again because of this, even to this day. The masts of many sailing ships were made from them. The Lebanon cedars were a symbol of enduring strength and power.



When Ezekiel talks about them, he is referring, in his time, to the mighty power of the Assyrian Empire. The northern kingdom placed its trust in this Empire. It was one of the birds (countries who nested in its branches), for its protection. That is until Assyria turned and conquered Israel, and sent a great deal of its population to be servants in their empire. Instead of relying on God, they relied on Assyria. That was a huge mistake; but then Assyria was conquered by the Babylonian Empire. It was God's doing.

Ezekiel next turns his parable against the princes of the southern Kingdom of Judah, who were afraid of the Babylonians. Once again, instead of trusting in God and being true to the Covenant, they were placing their hope on the strength of the Egyptian Empire (another kingdom he compared to the Cedars of Lebanon). Both Jeremiah and Ezekiel warned them about this false trust. Not only would Judah be defeated (586 B.C.), but Egypt would itself fall to the Babylonian Empire.

Jesus gives what seems to be a ridiculous and strange comparison about the kingdom of God. He alludes to Ezekiel's parable. Instead of a tree, a mighty Cedar of Lebanon, Jesus uses the symbol of the mustard seed and plant. The mustard seed was a very common plant, grown for its spice, but if not controlled, would just take over a field and keep expanding. No one would think of the mustard plant as tall or majestic or find comfort under its protection, right? But think more about it. If you think of big or tall, you would not think of a mustard plant. But if you think of expanse, it certainly can take over, it certainly becomes large. Then think of the large masses of the poor even today. Well, for the people of God's Kingdom, this is a number 1 priority!



The proud rulers of Israel (religious and secular) relied on the Roman Empire for security, power and the wealth it brought them. They were not taking care of the masses of poor, who were becoming poorer because of taxes. The rich and powerful were only thinking of themselves

Jesus conquered not by military power, but by humbling himself to be obedient to God His Father, the true source of eternal power. Our nation's politicians and mighty people have rejected God and God's laws. We are too sophisticated, too smart. We rely on science and power. We think we know better than God. What do you think the consequence for America will be?

Look around.

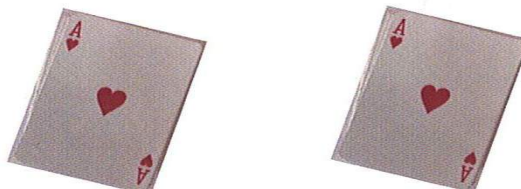

## A PARKWAY PARABLE

*A reflection for June 16, The Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time*



The highly travelled Garden State Parkway runs the length of the state of New Jersey. The trees that border that highway look lifeless in the winter. As spring approaches, drivers may notice a slight reddish tint on these trees as their buds come to life. As the days pass, that color changes to green as the buds begin to blossom. Slowly the trees come into leaf and the country-like road envisioned by its designers comes to life.

That gradual change along the Garden State Parkway is like the slow process of growth that Jesus speaks about in Sunday's Gospel. There Jesus tells two parables about seeds that slowly grow and bring forth a harvest.

This process of growth can also take place in our spiritual lives as we open ourselves to God's grace. Or to put it another way, we can change like the trees along the Garden State Parkway whose lifeless branches slowly take on a reddish tint, begin to bud, and then burst forth into a canopy of green.

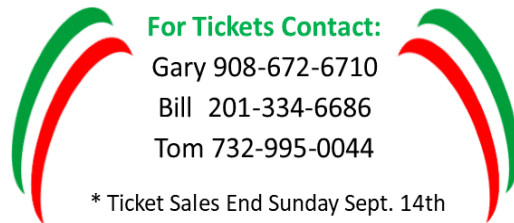

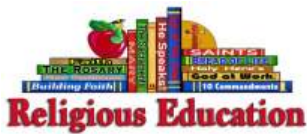
