

Trying to Understand God Better and Our Relationship with Him in the 21st Century

Dear Parishioners,

Many Catholics and other Christians are abandoning our faith because of the inconsistencies that appear to arise when we compare our Biblical faith heritage with the science of evolution cosmology, the problem of evil, and sin. This is especially pertinent to our families who have children who are in their early teens, who are learning some of these concepts in their school science programs. They are abandoning the Catholic faith in alarming rates, as we know. I greatly feel we need a synthesis of understanding of our Catholic faith in light of the sciences most of us accept. Very few authors or speakers seem to do a very convincing job of it. This is especially evident when it comes to teachings about the origins of man and the fall of man in the book of Genesis, and the need for Jesus as Our Savior. I have attempted to gain an understanding and explain it myself, but do not have the grace to do it very effectively. However, it is too important an issue to neglect for their sake. If we look at Bishop Robert Barron's website: <https://www.wordonfire.org/> on the internet, and conferences he is currently sponsoring and engaging in, we see this as a very critical concern of his as well. I hope his project is successful!

I am considering offering a series of classes for both of our parishes, as well as anyone else who would like to join us and begin explore these topics. I have been searching for a good book to begin our endeavor. The book I have chosen is called: Creation: A Catholic's Guide to God and the Universe, written by Christopher T. Bigelow. He is the director of the Science and Religion Initiative in the McGrath Institute for Church Life at the University of Notre Dame, where he also serves as a professor in the theology department. He is a consultant for the USCCB Committee on Catechesis and Evangelization and his 30-year career in Catholic education has spanned high school, undergraduate, graduate and seminary teaching. He lives with his family in the South Bend, Indiana, area.



Anointing of the Sick - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

Receiving Communion:

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and home-bound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

Its mission is to address the root causes of poverty in America through promotion and support of community-controlled, self-help organizations and through transformative education. 


