The Chrism Mass 2023

Bishop David M. O'Connell, C.M, and priests, deacons, religious and laity of the Diocese of Trenton will gather for the annual Chrism Mass at 7:30 p.m. in St. Robert Bellarmine Co-Cathedral, Freehold on Monday, April 3. The priests who gather to concelebrate this Mass publicly renew their commitment to their priestly promises made at ordination, and their service to the Bishop and the people of the Diocese of Trenton. It represents the unbroken ministry of the Priesthood of Jesus Christ of the bishop and priests since the time of the Apostles.

At this Mass the Holy Oils to be used during the conferral of Sacraments during this year are brought forward. Bishop O'Connell will consecrate the Sacred Chrism, and with the priests will also bless the Oil of the Infirm (sick) and the Oil of The Catechumens.

Chrism Oil is a mixture of olive oil and aromatic substance called Balsam which represents sweet aroma of Christ. It's used during Confirmation, Ordination of priest, Consecration of bishop, for consecration of altars and statues or images and Baptism. In Baptism the oil of Catechumen is used before the infant is baptized with water, after being baptized with water he or she is anointed with Chrism oil marking him or her as a Christian.

The oil of holy chrism holds great significance as it is utilized in sacraments that involve anointment with the Holy Spirit. This oil serves as a reminder that, as Christians, we are called upon to emit the 'fragrance' of Jesus Christ, or "*the smell of life leading to life*" (2 Corinthians 2:14, 16).

The Oil of Catechumens is a pure olive oil which is used to anoint infants and adults before they are baptized. Before the person is baptized, the Priest anoints the person's chest with the oil and says the prayer of exorcism saying "*We anoint you with the oil of salvation in the name of Christ our Savior; may He strengthen you with His power, who lives and reigns forever and ever.*" The use of this oil before baptism is to help the adult or infant overcome the influence of Satan, temptations, and to give them the power, faith and strength to serve God with their life.

The Oil of The Sick is also a pure olive oil. During the anointing the first effect of the sacrament is the forgiveness of sin. As oil heals the body, so does this holy oil heal the soul wounded by sin. Mortal sin must be eradicated by Baptism or Reconciliation, but Anointing of the Sick forgives venial sins that make us lethargic towards God. In the case when one is anointed while unconscious, a mortal sin may be forgiven, provided the sick person had contrition for the sin when they lost consciousness.

Anointing with oils signified God's blessing, strength, and favor, as exemplified in Psalm 45:8: "*Therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above other kings.*" This tradition was also carried over into early Christian worship, as they recognized not only the significance of oils but of who Jesus was. In the New Testament, Jesus is depicted as the ultimate priest, prophet, and king, who came to provide his people with abundant life. Interestingly, the term "messiah" translates to "anointed one."

Through blessing and utilizing the oils to bless others, we witness and experience Christ's divine work of blessing those who are lost and distant with his abundant life.



- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and home-bound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility


Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

Virtual Lourdes Experience

A non-Catholic woman who felt drawn to this program asked if she could stay. She was extremely moved and was crying throughout the program. She said she felt something inside of her that made her feel so peaceful.

A woman holding on from a traumatic experience of abuse from a family member, touched the rock from the grotto of our Lady of Lourdes and had a total feeling of healing and an uplifted feeling of gratitude, love and forgiveness and lightheartedness.

Another woman who had neuropathy in her both legs had no feeling whatsoever in them. She experienced trouble when trying to walk. When she felt pain she was extremely grateful and happy that she could actually feel something even though it was pain. And soon thereafter the pain was gone and both legs healed.

A 15 year old teenager from foster care, who has had trauma, abuse and neglect, volunteered to help at the Virtual Experience. She did this as part of completing her Confirmation hours since she is converting to Catholicism. She herself enjoyed the Virtual Experience while volunteering. She now feels a lot better and has experienced peace and is willing to volunteer more.




