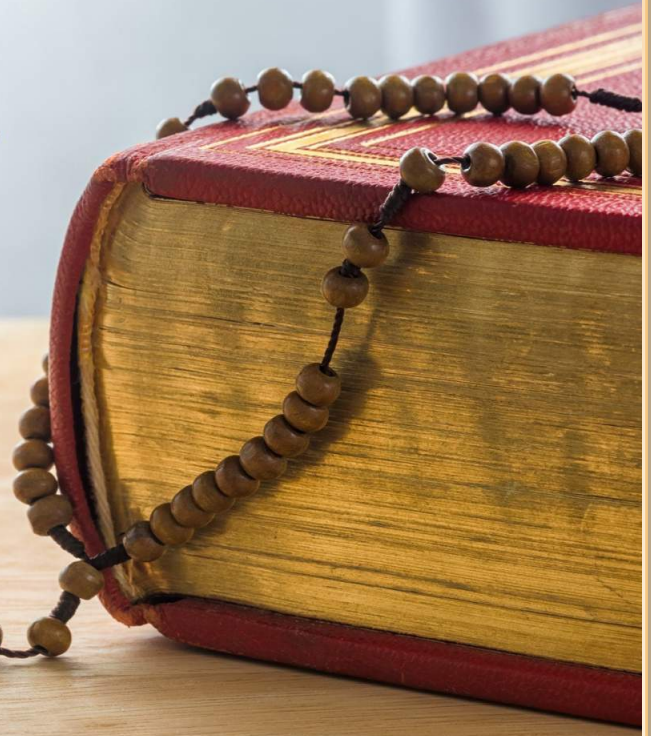

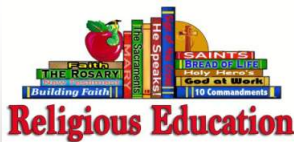

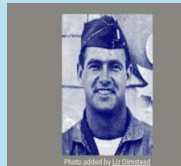
Gavio, Martin J., age 25, U.S. Army, 32nd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division. Gavio died on 15 February 1952

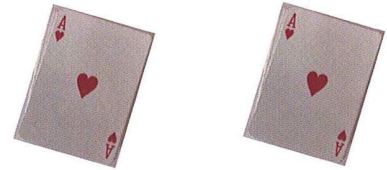
