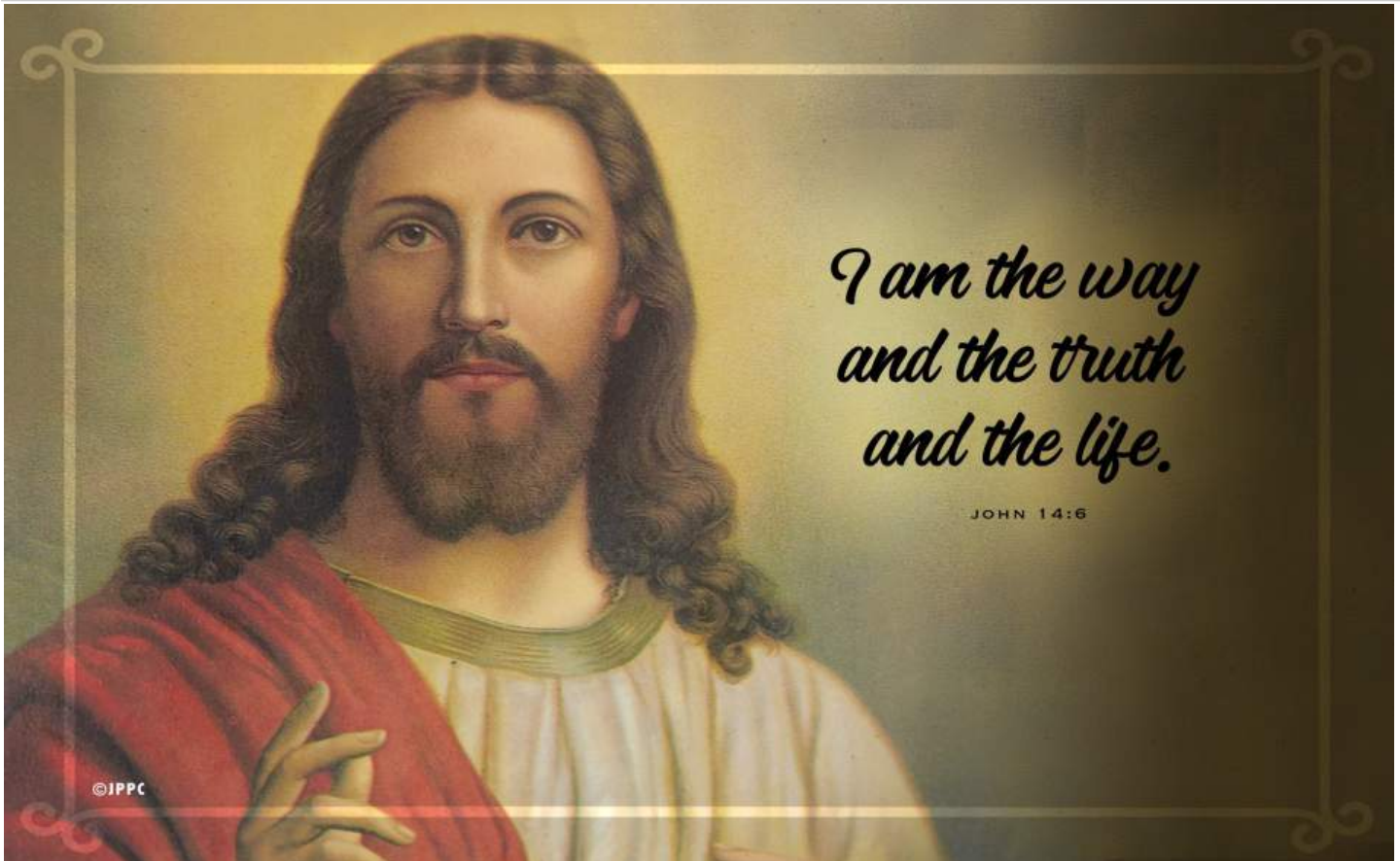

Dear Parishioners,

During Covid (Spring 2020 to Spring 2023) we lost a good number of Mass goers both in the Winter and the Summer at both parishes. I think we have stabilized now. There are many who probably won't be coming back.

## **Sacred Heart**

At Sacred Heart when there was the 6-foot apart requirement at Sacred Heart we added a 7:30am Mass to accommodate people's health concerns as well. It turned out that people at Sacred Heart liked the early morning Mass, so we are going to keep the early morning Mass, but are making the slight change of being at 7:15 am so there won't be traffic and parking concerns for the 8:30am Mass goers. It will still be a quiet Mass.

**The year-round weekend Mass schedule at Sacred Heart will be: Sat. at 4pm, and Sunday at 7:15am, 8:30am, and 10:30am.** The change from 7:30am to 7:15am mass will begin Memorial Day weekend.

**Holy Days of Obligation Masses at Sacred Heart will be 6:30pm Vigil Mass and 8:30am Daily Mass.**

### **Schedules for Christmas Masses are:**

2 Christmas Eve Masses at 4:00pm in The Church, and an overflow Mass in the Hall and Christmas Morning at 8:30am and 10:30am, with an overflow Mass in the Hall.

## **St. Pio**

At St Pio's where we have more of a need to save expenses, including heating in the winter, we will have a Summer Schedule and a Winter Schedule. In the Summer, we have a great increase in Mass attendance due to vacationers as well as residents who return from Florida and various other places.

The Summer weekend Mass Schedule at St. Pio's is Sat. at 5:00 pm, as people like to stay on the beach longer in the Summer.

**The Summer Mass Schedule at St Pio's will be: Sat. 5pm, and Sunday at 7:30am, 9:00am and 10:30am.** The Summer schedule will be from Memorial Day Weekend(2023) until the first weekend of October(2023).

**The Winter Schedule at St. Pio's will be Sat., at 4:00pm, and Sunday at 9:00am.** The Winter Schedule will be in effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend in October(2023) until the week before Memorial Day (2024).

**Holy Days of Obligation Masses at Saint Pio's will be 6:30pm Vigil Mass and 9:30am in the Church.**

### **Schedules for Christmas Masses are:**

Christmas Eve at 4:00pm and Christmas Morning at 9:00am

Note: The schedules for Easter will be published during Lent.

## **May is the Month of Mary**

***May is the month in which the earth springs into bloom and it is also the Month of Mary in which we honor Blessed Mary as the Mother of Jesus and our Heavenly Mother. Catholics have long honored Mary in May with special observances, traditions, and devotions. This tribute remains the entire month in order to memorialize the importance of our Mother Mary in Church and in our person lives. This devotion led to her to be known as the “Queen of May.”***

***Blessed Mary is honored or venerated as the mother of Christ, the most important woman in our Catholic faith. Our blessed Mother gave birth to that Body, making her our own mother: thus giving birth to us spiritually.***



***It's a Catholic tradition to honor Mary during the month of May by crowning her statue with flowers. The reason why we crown Mary is best summed up by Pope Paul VI who wrote in 1965 that May is an occasion for a “moving tribute of faith and love which Catholics in every part of the world pay to the Queen of Heaven.”***

***For May, give Mary a special spot in your house or prayer corner, It can be a statue or picture and a real tribute to her beauty and virtue. Crown Mary with a crown or wreath of flowers.***

***To our Blessed Mother, we fly to your protection, most holy Mother of God, please listen to our petitions and needs, and deliver us from all dangers, ever glorious and blessed Virgin Mary.***

***Mary, our Mother, by your obedience and patience you have taught us how to be true children of God. Please help us by your powerful assistance to overcome all our weakness, and to fulfill perfectly our tasks in life.***

***By you compassionate aid may we ever stand in spirit with you beneath the cross of Christ so that we may also rejoice with you in your divine Son's triumphant victory over sin and death.***

***In your maternal kindness help us to be faithful to prayer in the company of God's Church as you were one with the Apostles in the upper room as you waited for the promised Spirit of Pentecost.***

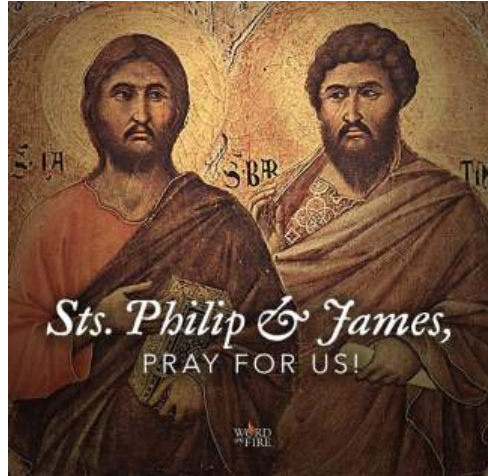
***With your gracious assistance may we be near you in the glory of Christ's kingdom come to sing with you and all the faithful the eternal praise of God. Amen.***

## PARISH INFORMATION

**Anointing of the Sick** - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

### **Receiving Communion:**

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and homebound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

## **Sponsorship Certificates** **Letters of Eligibility**

*Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).*

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

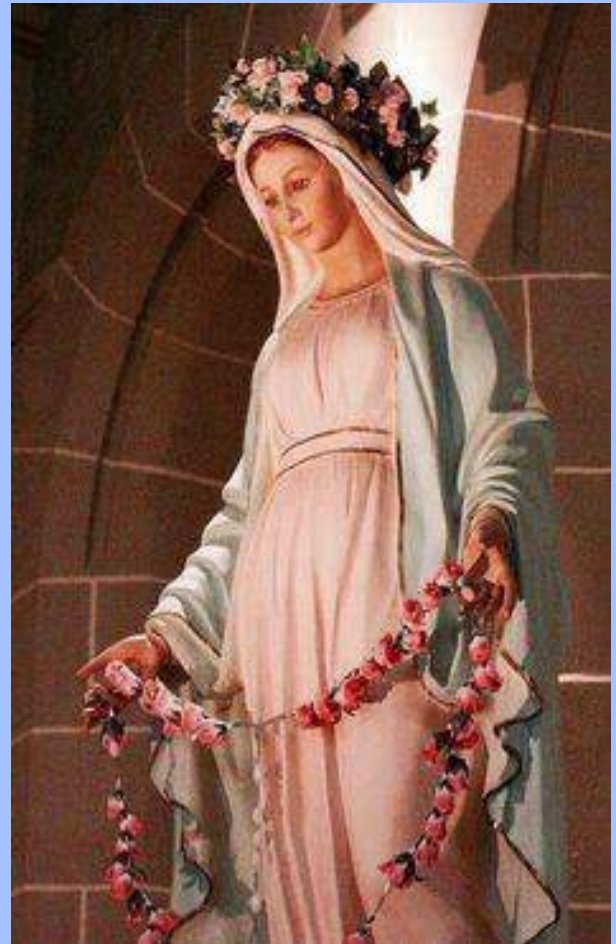
