5 PADRE PIO MIRACLES AND WHAT HE WANTS YOU TO KNOW ABOUT THEM

2. Healing the Blind

One of the most beautiful miracles of Padre Pio is the cure of Lello Pegna.

Lello was a Jewish man who had suddenly become blind. He was brought to Padre Pio by a priest in hopes of a cure. Upon meeting him, Padre Pio was kind to Lello, but told him, “*The Lord will not grant you the grace of physical sight unless you first receive sight for your soul. After you are baptized then the Lord will grant you the gift of sight.*”

Months went by before Lello would return to Padre Pio with his sight fully restored.

In spite of strong family opposition, Lello had converted to Christianity and was baptized. His miracle had not been immediate-his faith was tested when his blindness persisted. Gradually, however, Lello’s sight returned, and the doctor who had once pronounced him blind was astonished to discover that his patient’s eyes were now in perfect condition!

And Jesus said to Him, “Go your way; your faith has made you well.” - Mark 10:52

3. Miracles Through an Object

Most of the miracles attributed to Padre Pio occurred when he was **physically distant** from those who sought his intercession, such as the miracle experienced by Sr. Teresa Salvadores:

“Sister Teresa became bed-ridden at 58 yrs old. She suffered from gastric disorders (suspected to be caused by stomach cancer) and a painful abnormality of her aorta. The nun suffered from extreme pain, weakness, and vertigo, and her condition deteriorated until she was near death. Her fellow sisters were distraught. Many of them had heard stories about Padre Pio’s holiness and miracles. They wrote to Padre Pio, asking for his intercession for a cure.

About one month after the sister wrote to Padre Pio, a priest arrived at her convent bringing with him a glove that had been used by Padre Pio. The priest asked if he could touch the garment to the tumor in the nun’s side and to her throat.


Shortly afterwards, Sr. Teresa fell asleep. Padre Pio appeared to her in a dream, touching the side where her tumor was causing her pain, blew into her mouth and spoke to her about heaven. When Sr. Teresa woke up, all the physical sufferings caused by her conditions were relieved, though the tumors remained. The nun lived years without suffering from the effects of her abnormalities.

She said to herself, “If I only touch his garment, I shall be made well.”



Anointing of the Sick - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

Baptisms and Marriages

Please visit St. Pio's web site for information and call the parish office to schedule. www.stpioparish.com

Receiving Communion:

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and home-bound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility

Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.


