

## **5 PADRE PIO MIRACLES AND WHAT HE WANTS YOU TO KNOW ABOUT THEM**

-last in a series.

### **4. Casting Out Demons**

Padre Pio cast demons out of several people-and had physical altercations with Satan. People often turned to Pio when they suspected that demonic possession had overtaken their loved ones, as in the case of a young wife who had lain in a coma for a year. Her family brought her to Padre Pio's friary one evening during vespers. While Padre Pio was blessing the congregation with the Blessed Sacrament, the woman suddenly awoke and began snorting like a bull while her body swelled like a balloon. Once the service was over, Padre Pio quickly brought the woman and her husband into the sacristy, where he performed a formal rite of exorcism. During the prayers, the woman continued to snort, swell, and claw at Padre Pio. She became calm once Padre finished the prayers, and her normal appearance returned. Taking her husband's hand, she quickly became aware of (and appalled by) her disheveled appearance, asked for a comb, and left the friary.

### **5. Defying the Laws of Nature**

Perhaps Padre Pio's most surprising spiritual gift was the gift of bilocation. Padre Carmelo of Sessano, who was the superior of Padre Pio's friary between 1953-1959, tells an amusing account of one of these occasions:

He was with Padre Pio and some other friars attending a show at a concert hall that adjoined the friary. Padre Pio followed along during the show with great interest and enthusiasm. During the intermission, Padre Carmello recalls seeing Padre Pio leaned forward, resting his head and arms on the back of the chair in front of him, silent and motionless. The friars assumed that he was tired and did not want to disturb him while he rested for about five minutes. As the intermission ended, Padre Pio sat back up, and spoke with his fellow friars. They thought nothing of the incident until the next day. He was visiting a sick man in town, and the man thanked Padre Carmelo for allowing Padre Pio to visit him the previous evening. Padre Carmello was perplexed. He had been *with* Padre Pio at the concert hall-and Pio had gone straight back to the friary after the show. Pio hadn't left to visit anyone that evening.

When Padre Carmelo explained this to the man, he and his *entire* family insisted that Padre Pio had *physically* been in the house. When Padre Carmelo asked the precise time of the visit, the answer was the exact time of the show's intermission-during which Padre Pio appeared to be napping!

Padre Pio was once asked by a sick woman who he had cured, if he was a saint. "No," he replied. "I am a creature who serves the Lord through His mercies."

Padre Pio did not like the attention he received from being a miracle worker. Whenever a person came to him for a cure, He usually gave a quick reply such as, "Let us pray to God." *He always made sure to point people back to the source of the miracles: God.*

Padre Pio referred to himself as a poor sinner who prayed, and encouraged others to do likewise. When people thanked him for performing a miracle, he would reply with embarrassment.

"Don't thank me, Thank God."

### **Receiving Communion:**

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and home-bound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

## **Sponsorship Certificates Letters of Eligibility**

*Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).*

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.
- 

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.






