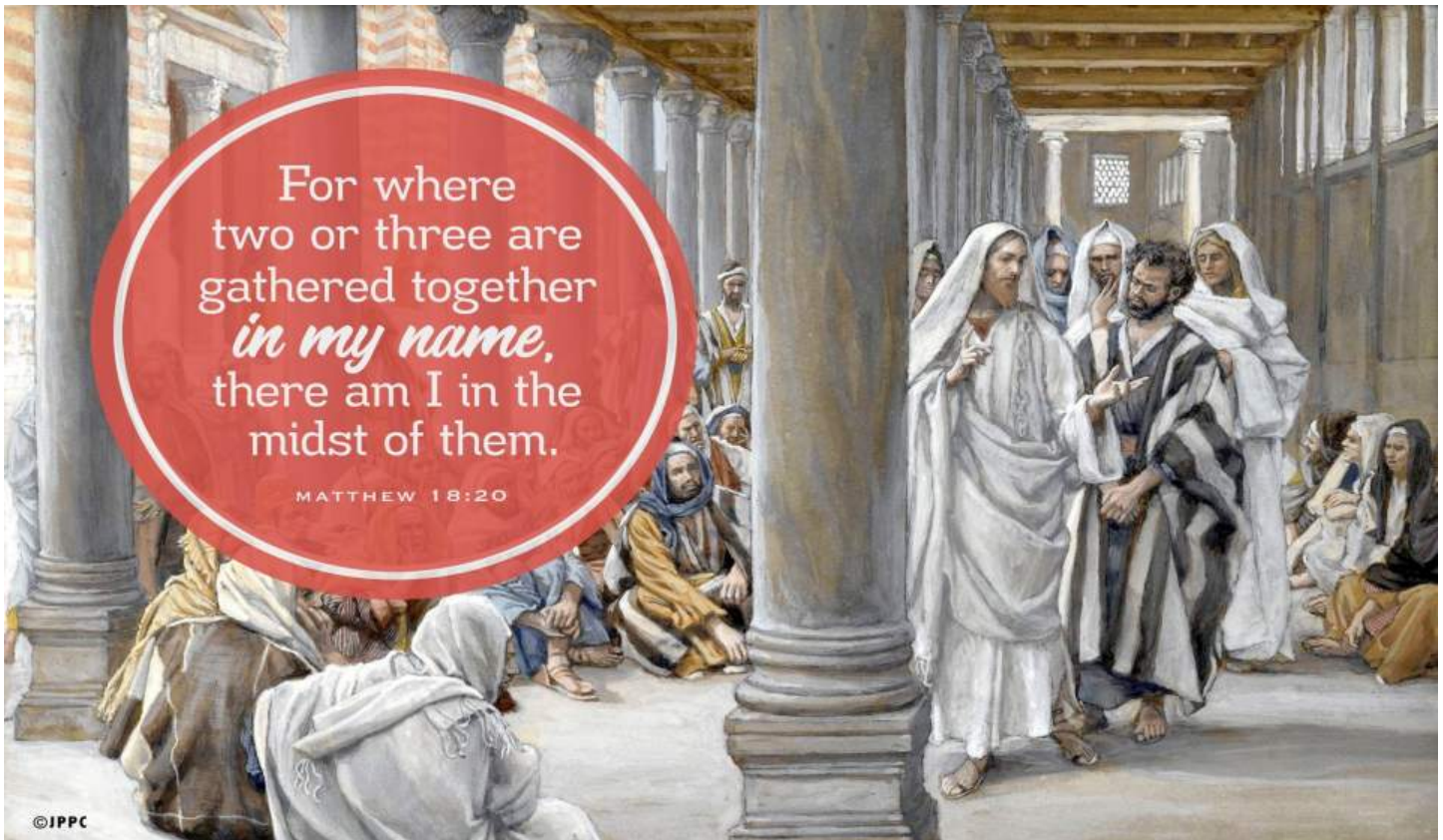

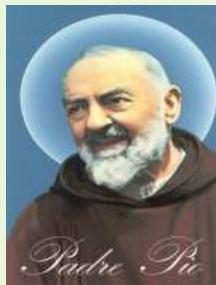

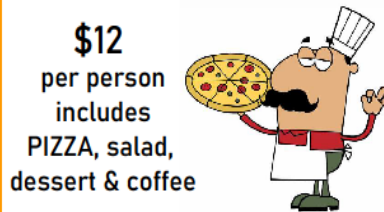

**Request for Donations from Fr Ashe**

In 2018, Americas Gleaned Seafood, (AGS) a New Jersey 501 (c)(3) nonprofit was formed to make fresh, NJ caught, protein-rich seafood available to New Jersey's food banks

on a regular, sustainable basis. New Jersey is home to a robust commercial fishing industry. The state's 6 major ports harvest more than 120 million pounds of seafood annually. But a large percentage - up to 25 million pounds - is "bycatch", meaning it is not the fishermen's targeted species or for a variety of reasons, it is not marketable (National Marine Fisheries Service & NOAA, 2013). Per current regulations, this bycatch is discarded overboard, but it is perfectly good and could be donated to help feed people in need. Most fishers would prefer to do so, but there's never been a workable process in place to do so. That is the reason AGS was created.

AGS works with commercial fishers to donate excess seafood and deliver it to local food pantries to help feed low-income families. Since last November, AGS has gleaned and provided 2,186 pounds of seafood, which includes Porgies, Fluke, Blue Seabass, Butterfish, Talapia, Whiting, Monkfish, Squid and Skate to two soup kitchens - St. Vincent DePaul in Lakewood and True Vine Ministry in Bayville. This fish provided 8,744 fresh seafood meals to 2,915 families in the last 9 months.

Americas Gleaned Seafood utilized previous donations to purchase waxed boxes that the gleaned seafood is packaged into in order for it to be distributed to families.

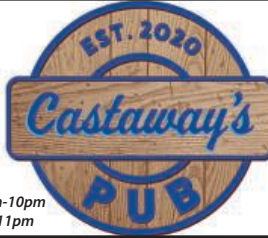
