## ***From Fr. Joe***

### **5 PADRE PIO MIRACLES AND WHAT HE WANTS YOU TO KNOW ABOUT THEM**

St. Padre Pio, whose feast we celebrate on September 23rd, is one of the most famous and beloved saints of the 20th century.

As a humble Capuchin priest, he was the recipient of some of the most astonishing spiritual gifts, the stigmata, bilocation, healing prophesy, and the ability to read souls.

He quickly gained the attention of thousands due to the countless miracles attributed to him. Crowds traveled from all over the world to meet him or have him hear their Confession. To this day, the stories about his miracles continue to inspire belief in those who were previously skeptical.

Before we read about some of Padre Pio's most incredible miracles, let's remind ourselves what the purpose of miracles is in the first place.

### **Padre Pio's Miracles Witness to Christ**

The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines miracles as "a sign or wonder such as a healing, or control of nature, which can only be attributed to God."

Jesus performed countless miracles—by His own power—throughout His public ministry to demonstrate His divinity and to point us to His Heavenly Kingdom. While reading through stories of Padre Pio's miracles, what struck me most was how similar the miracles performed by Padre Pio were compared with those performed by Christ!

Of course, the saints do not perform miracles by their own power, but are channels of God's power. He works through them and through the conformity of their will to His.

Still, we can see that Padre Pio and his miracles were a humble reflection of Christ Himself.

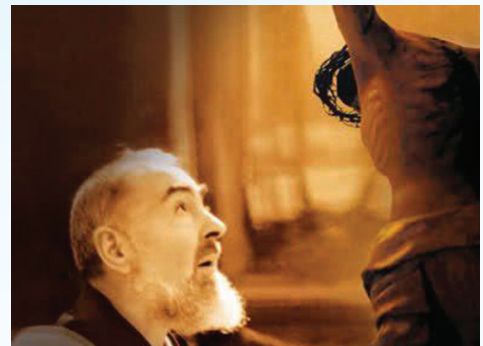
### **The Healing of a Crippled Man**

Francesco Santarello was a crippled man with club feet, dubbed the village idiot of San Giovanni Rotondo. Unable to walk, he would drag himself along the ground on his knees with the assistance of small crutches. He frequently stationed himself outside of St. Padre Pio's friary to beg for money among the crowds of people who came to see the famous capuchin. One day, as Padre Pio was walking by, Francesco cried out, "Padre Pio, give me a blessing!" Padre Pio looked at the man and said "Throw away your crutches!" Francesco was stunned and did not move. Padre Pio shouted again, "I said, 'Throw away your crutches!'" and left the man, walking into Church to say Mass.

The crowds watched in amazement as Francesco threw his crutches away, and, for the first time in his life, walked on his deformed feet. Francesco would never use his crutches again.

**Anointing of the Sick** - This sacrament is for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass to receive this sacrament or call the parish office for an appointment.

**Baptisms and Marriages**

**Receiving Communion:**

- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand. Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue should wait until the end of the Communion distribution and receive from the Priest.
- Only Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion with a valid Sacred Heart/St. Pio ID card can receive Communion in a Pyx to take to the sick and homebound. For anyone that is not a Eucharistic Minister and is requesting a Host needs to see the Priest before or after Mass. Hosts will not be distributed during Mass.
- If you need a low gluten Host, please go to the Communion line in the front on the pulpit side, and ask the Eucharistic Minister.

**Sponsorship Certificates  
Letters of Eligibility**

*Godparents and sponsors, together with the parents must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).*

A sponsor must:

- be at least 16 years of age.
- have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation.
- if married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- attend Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.
- be registered at the Parish of St. Pio of Pietrelcina for at least six (6) months prior to the request.
- 

Please note, if you received all your sacraments at St. Pio of Pietrelcina years ago but now live elsewhere, you are a member of the parish in whose territory you reside. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

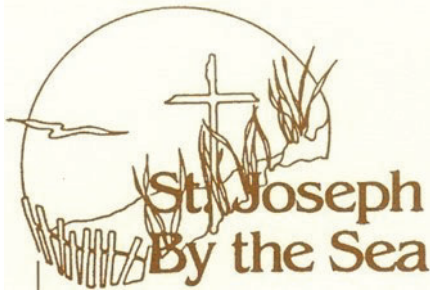
