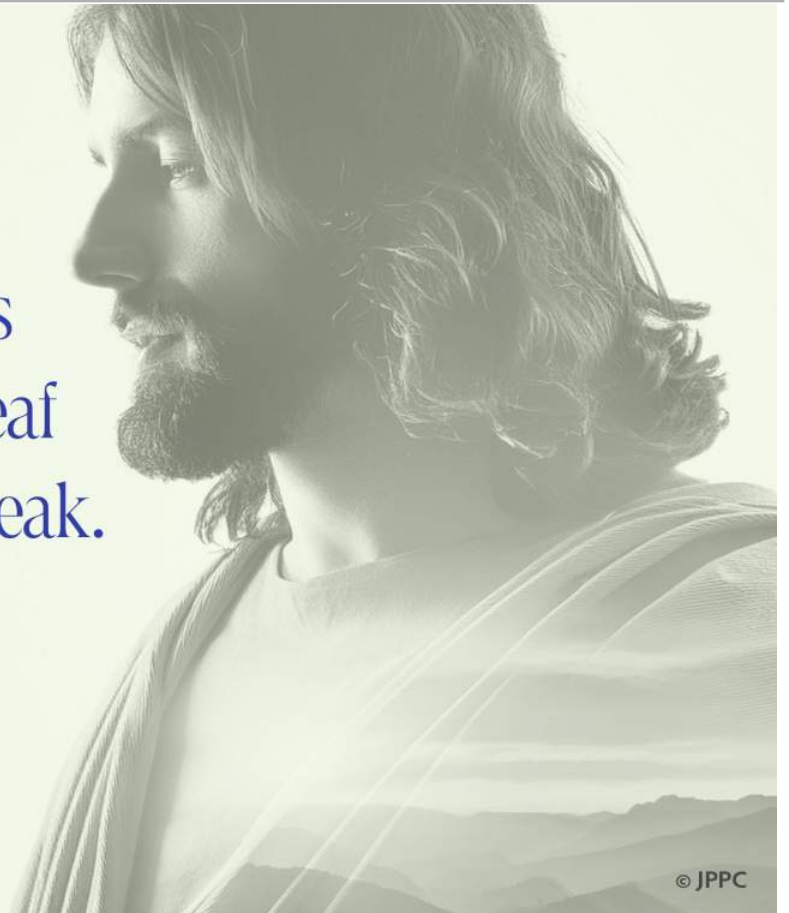

## **Mortal Sin Prevents a Person From Worthily Receiving Holy Communion at Mass**

(Part 4 of 4 continued from last week)

If you do receive, you are committing another grave sin of sacrilege, which may be mortal. If you are uncertain you must go to confession before you receive. The article below is a relatively good understanding of classifying sins as mortal and venial. I have made **edits (bold face type)**.

### **What are the Common Examples of Mortal Sins?**

#### **4. Stealing**

Stealing is also a mortal sin. It doesn't matter how much or how little you stole. The simple act of taking something that's not yours is a direct violation of the seventh commandment, making it a grave sin. Theft. Even St. Paul wrote in the bible that thieves and swindlers have no place in the kingdom of God (1 Corinthians 6:9-10).

Robbery. This form of stealing involves using violence, force, or intimidation to take other people's belongings. By the very grave nature of this act, it should be no wonder that this is a mortal sin.

#### **5. Deadly sins**

The seven deadly sins are considered to be the most serious sins man can commit. As such, they deserve a spot on this list.

As per Catholic teachings, the seven deadly sins include:

**Pride - Anger - Lust - Envy - Gluttony - Avarice - Sloth**

#### **6. Taking advantage of the poor**

According to Pope Pius X, oppressing the poor and taking advantage of their plight is one of those sins that cry to God for vengeance. This includes defrauding your workers of their wages. It's equivalent to stealing, which is another grave offense. These acts are not only sinful in the eyes of God but also of men.

#### **7. Blasphemy**

In his writings, St Thomas Aquinas states that "blasphemy or any word or deed that is an insult to God is much more grievous than perjury." Using the name of the Lord in vain is not only an insult to the holiness of His name but also a violation of the second commandment.

Asking for God's Forgiveness

Catholic tradition dictates that those who die with mortal sins are doomed to suffer in hell. But the good news is that our God is a very merciful God. Yes, committing a sin cuts you off from God's grace. But it doesn't have to stay that way forever. It's the reason why He sent His only son because He doesn't want us to be bound in sin forever (John 3:16).

According to the gospel of St. John, if we only confess our sins, he will forgive us and purify us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). For we all have sinned, but through Christ's blood, we have been redeemed (Colossians 1:22). If we repent our sins and return to God, He will wash away our sins and lead us to a new and everlasting life (Acts 3:19).

## Sacred Heart Stained Glass Window Repair Update

**Good News:** the repair of our windows is ahead of schedule and should be complete in the next 10 days.

The reason we are doing the repairs is WATER; water has infiltrated the windows and caused damage. In the past, caulk and other sealants were placed on the interior perimeter to mitigate water issues but it only hid the problem and caused further damage. The steel ventilators rusted out and spalled (expanded) and caused some of the glass to break. Also, moisture got trapped between the exterior glass and stained glass, this caused the wood frames to swell and put additional pressure on the windows; the glass cracked and the lead was starting to fail. Minor bowing was found on some of the glass panels, some of the wood frames are mishapen and do not fit properly. The large exterior glass panel over the nativity window broke due to frame pressure.

The windows were removed, taken back to the studio and restored, each piece of glass was cleaned by hand, each panel was rebuilt with new lead. Broken glass was repaired with glass epoxy and shattered glass was recreated by internationally trained stained-glass artists. New aluminum cross bars are being installed on the restored glass. Once completed, laminated glass with ventilation holes will be placed on the exterior and sealed. The cost for the repair of our altar windows and the choir loft windows is \$77,363.

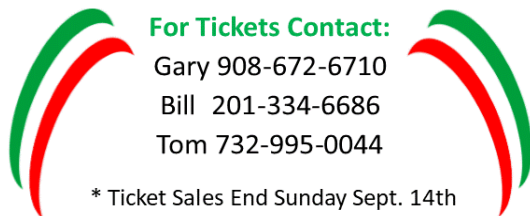

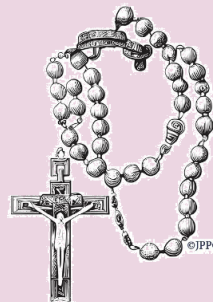
## Right to Life Ministry

## **MADE TO HEAR AND SPEAK**

*A reflection for September 8, The Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time*

“Then will the eyes of the blind be opened, the ears of the deaf be cleared; then will the lame leap like a stag, then the tongue of the mute will sing.” These words from our First Reading speak of the wondrous things that will happen when God comes to save his people.

In our Gospel, we see Jesus, the Savior, fulfilling that prophecy of Isaiah. The people bring a deaf man with a speech impediment to Jesus and beg him “to lay his hand on him.” Jesus touches the man’s ears and tongue, looks up to heaven and says “*Ephphatha*”/“Be opened.” The man is cured. That prophecy continues to come true, for what the man in the Gospel experienced is something that we also experience in our lives.

The Lord Jesus opens our ears. After the First and the Second Reading are proclaimed at Mass, the lector says, “The word of the Lord.” Then we respond, “Thanks be to God,” in acknowledgement that we have just heard God speak to us.

We live in a world where the ears and hearts of many people are closed to the message of God. Yet we are able hear and recognize God’s voice for the Lord Jesus has touched our ears and said, “Be opened.”

By our “Amen,” we can acknowledge that the consecrated bread and wine are the very Body and Blood of Christ. By our words of sorrow in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we can be freed of our sins and be given a new start in life.

Today we are reminded that the Lord Jesus who opened the ears and mouth of the man in the Gospel has touched our ears and mouth as well. If he had not done so, we would be deaf to God’s word and unable to profess our faith.
